## Suggested China Requirements for Stocking and Servicing a New Installation

To insure the maximum life for your Jackson China, an adequate supply should be on hand at all times. The seating capacity usually determines your requirements.

In dining rooms with a seating capacity from 20 to 150 the following Jackson China should be on hand.

Cups . . . . .	3 - 4 times the number of seats
Saucers . . . . .	2½ - 3 times the number of seats
Sauce Dishes . . . . .	3 - 4 times the number of seats
Soup and Cereal Bowls . . . . .	2½ - 3 times the number of seats
Small Plates . . . . .	3 - 4 times the number of seats
Large Plates . . . . .	2½ - 3 times the number of seats
Platters . . . . .	½ the number of seats

The above represents the minimum requirements for a new installation.

Self service cafeterias where breakage is higher should carry an additional reserve stock.

All the items listed herein can be furnished in White Body Chinaware. Practically all of the items, with the exception of the Chinese items, can be furnished in Jac-Tan Body. We reserve the right to discontinue or add items to this list, at any time conditions justify such action, without advance notice.

Dealer's orders can be more promptly handled, and correspondence and time saved, if the orders are carefully and correctly composed and items are not included that are not covered by this catalogue. Common errors include failure to specify body color, the practice of listing trade sizes when the dealer meant them to be actual sizes, and the lack of indicating whether RE regular rim or NR narrow rim or Carlton, Ritz or Roosevelt ware is desired.

All orders are shipped F.O.B. Falls Creek, Pa., standard packing charges are included. Invoices are subject to net cash settlement within 30 days from date of invoice. If invoices are paid within 15 days from date of invoice a one percent (1%) cash discount will be allowed, but no discount will be allowed on prepaid freight charges.

It is impossible to limit quantities accurately in the manufacture of Chinaware. Therefore, in harmony with the general custom and practice in the trade, orders are considered complete if within 10%—either under or over—of the quantities specified.

Cancellation of orders will not be accepted after they have been placed in work in our factory. We reserve the right to cancel any orders or parts of orders that we find impractical to execute.

Liquid capacities listed herein are brimful measurements and not practical serving capacities. All capacities and sizes as listed are subject to slight variations due to the process of Chinaware manufacturing.

All ware is packed and shipped in good order. Claims for loss or damage must be made by the consignee with the carrier.

No orders or quotations are binding upon us until accepted or confirmed by our Falls Creek office and the order is also subject to approval at the home office of the Company and/or the Credit Manager at Pelham Manor, New York.
